

Flying Saucer



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 x Plastic Cup
- 1 x CD
- Card
- Colouring pencils/pens
- Hot glue (PVA could be used but will take longer to set)

Optional

- Sharpies/Permanent markers
- Googly Eyes
- Pipe Cleaners
- Pom poms

Instructions

1- First make the alien and the steering wheel. Draw an alien figure (note: one alien feature is their oversized head and small body) colour this in and then cut around the outside of the shape. The steering wheel can be simply a circle (or you can be totally creative and design an alien switch board). *Alternatively the alien and the steering wheel can also be formed using pipe cleaners and pom poms... or any item you wish.*

2- Next is time to decorate the ship, although this can be done at the end it can be easier to decorate before assembling. Decorate the CD and the plastic cup with shapes cut from card.

The ship could also be decorated using small embellishments, sequins, glitter or simply draw shapes using sharpies/permanent markers.

3- Using your glue you need to now assemble this ship. Firstly glue the alien and steering wheel into place on the center of the CD. Next glue the cup onto the CD locking the alien into its ship.

Handy tip

If you are doing this activity with younger children you may want to draw a template wheel and alien and photocopy onto some light card so they can just colour it in and cut out.
