

CD Mandalas

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1x CD
- Black Relief Outliner
- PVA
- Dye (artists dye or food colouring will work the same)
- Whiteboard marker

Optional/Alternative

- Permanent Markers



Instructions

1- Plan and draw out the design you want on your CD with a whiteboard marker. Then use the black relief outliner to outline your pattern, remember with the relief its meant to be a raised line not too thin. Set the CD aside to dry.

2- Once dry you need to fill in the gaps with a mixture of PVA and dye, a few drops mixed into the glue will do fine (the colours will be pastel coloured but they will dry transparent)

3- Continue to fill in all the colours of the pattern. Leave to dry, the colours will be transparent when dry.

Alternatively

If you don't have the relief liner or don't have time for the liner to dry then you can use a black permanent marker to outline the design and then carry on with the colouring. Keep in mind it is a bit harder to keep your colours separate without the raised border, so if this is being done with young children you may want to ensure you have the liner.
