

# Make A Reindeer Game

## Items needed (quantity per creation)

- Card
- Dice
- Colouring equipment
- Clear confectionery plastic bag (or zip lock bag)
- Ribbon

## Optional

- Felt to replace card
- Googly eyes
- Embellishments



## Instructions

1- Start by cutting off the game zone and setting it aside. The colour in the pieces at the bottom of the template, don't be too worried about the lines, as you will cut them off.

2- Cut out all the pieces.

4- Get all the game pieces and a dice and put it in the confectionery bag. Punch a whole in the bag and the game board(s) and tie together with ribbon.

If you want you can turn this into a multilayer gift by making two sets so you can race each other while playing. Hours of fun in this game

## Got older children?

If you have older children in your programme you may want to not give them the template and get them to invent their own version of the game. It could be a Christmas tree or scene or anything really as long as there a 6 different elements to collect.

You could also substitute out the card for felt to make a longer lasting game.

GAME ZONE



*Who can be first to roll a reindeer?*

Each player has a turn at rolling the dice, whatever number it lands on will match a part of the reindeer head. When you roll that number you can place that item onto your game zone to start creating.

If you roll a number that you have already completed for example you roll a 4 and you already have two eyes on your game zone then you do not get to play anything. Keep taking turns rolling the dice and try to be the first to complete your reindeer in the playspace.
