Peg Advent Calendar



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- Old Christmas card (or coloured card)
- 25 medium sized Pegs (+1 if you want a day holder)
- Colouring equipment
- Hot glue (or PVA)
- Ribbon or string.

Optional

- Wrapping paper
- Embellishments

Instructions

- 1- Start by cutting a circle out of an old Christmas card (template attached has two sizes pick the one that suits). Then start gluing down the pegs, at the 3, 6 and 9 positions
- 2- Fill in the gaps using the remaining pegs, (5 pegs before 3, 6 pegs between 3-6 and 6-9 then 5 more after the 9. From here you will want to attach a loop with ribbon or sting so it can be hung up
- 3- Now you will need the day markers to put in the pegs, these are made from small circles of card (or strips if it's easier). Then write the numbers 1-25 on it.
- 4- DECORATE, add some embellishments or words to make it stand out. You may also want to add an extra peg to show what day your up to.

Alternative

This great little craft is easy and effective. This set of instructions shows the lolly-free version of this, but if you wish to go all out you can simply write the numbers on the pegs and attach lollies on each of them.

You can also make a larger version using a paper plate and large pegs - great decoration for a programme.
