
# **Ribbon Rockets**



# Items needed (quantity per creation)

- Card
- Balloon Stick
- Cardboard roll
- Colouring equipment
- Ribbon
- Hot glue (or PVA)

#### Optional

• Embellishments

## Instructions

This is a great craft to change up, although there is a template for a rocket you could inspire the children to design their own spacecraft, car, boat.... even a magical pixie.


1- Colour in the template (or draw and colour in your own design) then cut it out.

2- Next glue pieces of ribbon at the base of the rocket, in this case fire colours were used to show the lift off blast.

3- Glue the rocket onto the cardboard roll and then attach a balloon stick. Now you can fly your rocket to the moon and back.


### Alternative

Cardboard rolls may be hard to find or collect before your activity. If you cant get any in time you can simply glue the template onto some thick card before you cut out the rocket. Then glue straight onto a balloon stick.
