


Go Fishing



Items needed (quantity per creation)


- Plastic paper (folder dividers work well) or foam paper
- Black permanent marker
- Paper clips
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Stick approximately 1 metre (anything that is not bendable will do)
- Hot glue
- Electrical tape
- String approximately 1.5 m
- 1 Magnet

Instructions

This craft will create a fun game that children can play with. It is better suited to younger children however a few small changes and make it a lot more challenging for older children.

- 1- Start by drawing your fish shape onto the plastic/foam paper. You will want to create a few of these to enjoy the game.
- 2- Cut around the shapes you have drawn. At this point if you want to assign points for each fish you can with a permanent marker
- 3- Place a paper clip onto the fish where the mouth would be and secure with a dot oh hot glue. If you are doing this craft with older children make sure the paper clip overhangs like the picture so they can hook their catch.

4- Next we are going to make the rods. You can make one or if you want more than one person to fish at once you could make many. Start by placing your length of string beside your rod starting half way along the rod. Tape the string to the rod at the end of the string and the end of the rod itself. This will make it more secure while playing.

5- This step is to make it harder to play so skip this step if its for younger children. Take a paper clip, pull out one end to create a 'hook' then tie to the end of the string.

6- This step is for younger children. Hot glue a magnet to the end of the string.

Now you can use your rod to go fishing. Place your fish in water and use the rod to catch them. The younger children will find it easier as the magnet will attach faster. The older children will have to try out their hand eye coordination to hook the 'hook' through the paper clip.
