

Bottle Kerplunk



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 2 plastic bottles
- 10 Kebab sticks
- Tape
- Scissors
- Marbles
- Big sewing needle
- Nail

Instructions

Some bottles may be hard to cut and you may need to use a craft knife. The craft knife should be used by an adult so children don't get cut.

- 1- Cut your bottles in half. Only the bottoms are needed.
- 2- In one half cut small 1cm long cuts around the top, this is so it is easier to place in the other half later.
- 3- Use the needle to punch holes for the kebab sticks. If the holes aren't big enough then use a nail to make the holes bigger. Make sure there are at least 24 holes (two per kebab stick and then a few extra)

Bottle Kerplunk cont.

4- Use the cuts from step two and place the two open ends of the bottles together and put one slightly inside the other. This will help reinforce the tape. Then tape around the outside of the bottle.



5- Cut a small hole big enough to fit marbles through into the end of the bottle without the holes. This will be where you put in the marbles and get them when they fall.



6- Place your creation upside down and fill with marbles. Put your kebab sticks through the holes in the bottle and turn over to play.



Gameplay

Players take turns to remove kebab sticks one at a time. The aim is to not let the marbles fall so pick carefully. When marbles fall from a stick being moved those marbles are collected by that player. The one with the least marbles at the end of the game is the winner.
