Thumb Piano



Instructions

1- Cut your piece of wood into a 10x10cm square. Stretch bobby pins. This is easily done with your fingers.

2- Paint wood in African patterns if desired.

3- Measure and mark 2cm intervals along one edge to make it easier to place bobby pins evenly. Place a line of glue at each of your marked intervals. Glue bobby pins one at a time as you will need to hold it for a few seconds while it dries. (you may have to hold bobby pins in place for a few seconds while it dries so this is easier to do one bobby pin at a time).

Your piano is now ready to play.

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- Wood MDF or similar (Recycled wood from cabinets works well)
- 4 x Bobby pins
- Super glue

• Paint or paint pens (for decorating if desired)
