

Floating Chalk Printing



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 A4 piece of card
- Sidewalk chalk (variety of colours, or soft chalk pastels for brighter prints)
- Large metal baking tray for water (or similar item that will fit your paper and hold water)
- Spoon

Optional

- Hairspray/fixative

Instructions

1- Fill your metal baking tray with water. Next get your chalks and use a spoon to scrape off chalk dust into the water (the chalk dust should float).

2- Once you have the desired look for your print, lower your card into the water. Ensure all the paper looks wet as any part that doesn't get wet will not print. Then carefully lift off.

3- Put your prints somewhere flat to dry and then if you wish you can coat the artwork with hairspray to set the chalk in place.

Use for the prints

These prints look great on their own but could be used to make cards by folding into quarters or they could be turned into bookmarks by cutting them smaller and then laminating them... the options are endless.
