Jandal Stamps



Items needed

- Jandals
- Foam card (the thicker the better)
- Hot Glue
- Pencils or pens

For the artwork

- Shallow trays or plates for paint
- Paint
- · Plain fabric or paper

Instructions

Hint

- 1- Take some foam card and draw shapes for your stamps, then cut them out. If your foam card is thin, you may need to cut out three identical ones and glue them together.
- 2- Hot glue the shapes to the bottom of the jandals. It works best if there is a pattern that covers most the bottom of the jandal.
- 3- Fill some shallow plates or trays with paint (just enough to stamp with if it's too deep, it will get on the jandal itself and print the jandal). Then just walk over your paper or fabric. Repeat till you have an amazing artwork.



The printing itself can be very messy. So it's best done outside on a large tarp or by using poster paints. When you are finished you can simply wash away the left over paint.
