## Sock Bunnies



## Instructions

This activity can be altered to suit multiple ages, to make it a little more challenging for older children replace gluing of the ears, nose and tail for sewing with needle and thread.

1- Start by filling your sock with enough tissue paper (or hobby fill) to make a ball shape, then mark out two ear shapes by cutting out a large 'v' that ends at the top of the filling. Pinch the ear pieces together and hot glue so the ball is shut.

2- Use a piece of ribbon and tie a bow to keep the ears together.

3- Add the eyes, nose and tail to the bunny with hot glue like the photo below. Use a permanent marker to draw the mouth.

## Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 sock (any colour)
- Ribbon approx 10cm
- Googly eyes
- 1 small pink pom pom
- 1 large white pom pom for tail
- Permanent marker
- Tissue paper or hobby fill
- Hot Glue

## Optional

- Embellishments
- Needle and thread
