

# Egg Decorating - Sprinkles

## Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1x Blown or plastic egg
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brush

## Optional

- Kebab stick



## Instructions

The kebab stick can be useful to put through the egg to hold it while painting.

- 1- Paint your egg white if not already white.
- 2- Use a small paintbrush to paint different coloured sprinkles one colour at a time.

Simple but effective.



# Egg Decorating - Ninjas

## Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1x Blown or plastic egg
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brush
- Permanent marker
- Hot glue
- Toothpicks

## Optional

- Kebab stick



## Instructions

The kebab stick can be useful to put through the egg to hold it while painting.

- 1- Paint your egg black. Remember to leave a small rectangle for the eye area.
- 2- Use the permanent marker to draw on two eyes and eyebrows (see image). Then paint on a belt, what colour?.. you choose.
- 3- Use the hot glue to glue the toothpicks on the back in an 'X' formation. These will be the ninja's swords



# Egg Decorating - Unicorns

## Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1x Blown or plastic egg
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brush
- Permanent marker
- Hot glue
- Foam card (regular card will work too)

## Optional

- Kebab stick



## Instructions

The kebab stick can be useful to put through the egg to hold it while painting.

1- Start by painting your egg white. While the paint dries cut out a quarter of a circle (this will be the horn) and 5+ flowers out of the foam card.

2- Use the permanent marker to draw on the eyes (see image two)

3- Roll the quarter circle to make a horn, glue down the side then attach to the top of the egg. If you wish you can use the permanent marker to draw a spiral on the horn.

4- Glue the flowers around the horn and down the back of the egg, this is to represent the mane.



# Egg Decorating - Dragons

## Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1x Blown or plastic egg
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brush
- Permanent marker
- Hot glue
- Foam card (regular card will work too)

## Optional

- Kebab stick



## Instructions

The kebab stick can be useful to put through the egg to hold it while painting.

- 1- Start by painting the egg whatever colour you want your dragon to be.
- 2- While this dries cut a length of foam board approx 11cm long and shape into spike shapes. Once your egg has dried, hot glue this from the top of the egg down the back.
- 3- Trim off the excess and then glue back on at the base for the tail.
- 4- Use the permanent marker to draw on the face (see image four)
