Felt Bunnies



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- A4 white felt sheet
- Felt (any colour of your choice for ear inside)
- Needle
- Thread
- Hot glue
- Googly eyes


Instructions

This craft is better suited to older children. If you want to do it with younger children you could simply hot glue the pieces instead of stitching them

- 1- Start by cutting out the template and tracing it onto the felt (don't worry these lines will end up inside the bunny)
- 2- Cut out all the pieces.
- 3- Take the inner ear and place it on the white ear on one of the body pieces. Blanket stitch around

Note: Blanket stitch - Tie a knot in the end of your thread. Push your needle down into the fabric and tie a knot to secure. Come back up through the fabric and put the needle through the loop created before pulling firm. Continue coming up and going through the loop. If you are having trouble youtube has many good tutorials.

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Felt Bunnies cont.

- 4- Once you have gone around one side of the inner ear join both body pieces and stitch around.
- 5- When the inner ear is attached then stitch up both sides of the body, don't stitch up the base. Use your scraps of felt to lightly stuff the bunny.
- 6- Now stitch the oval base to the bottom of the bunny.
- 7- Add the googly eyes with hot glue to the sides of the bunny.
