

Floating Flowers

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- PVA
- Transparency sheet
- Flowers or nature (dried in advance if possible)
- 2 Square or paper plates (a photo frame would work well to)
- Hot glue
- Scissors

Optional

- Embellishments



Instructions

This craft will work with fresh flowers or leaves but if they are dried they will last forever in this awesome craft.

- 1- Start by preparing your nature. If you want to dry your flowers yourself you can place them in a hardcover book between sheets of baking paper on separate pages, then place that book under something heavy or in a vice for a week.
- 2- Take your transparency sheet and glue down your nature with PVA glue. Note the glue will dry clear so don't worry about that. Leave to partially dry
- 3- Coat the other side of the nature in glue to seal them in.

Floating Flowers cont.

4- While your glue is drying, cut out the base of your two square plates like the picture. These will become the frame. This is the point where you would decorate your frame if desired.

5- Use the two plates like a sandwich and place your dried flower sheet between it. Use dabs of hot glue to fix into place.

Don't worry if there are still some white parts in your glue they will dry over time.
