

Jar Lid Sun Catchers



Items needed (quantity per creation)

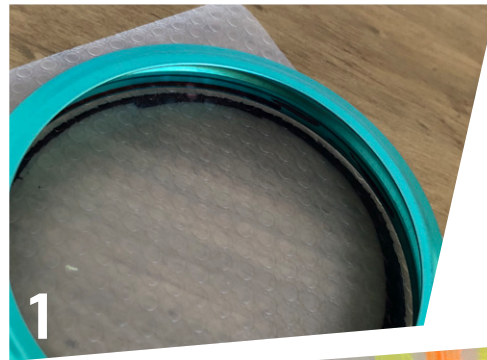
- 1x Preserving jar screw band (found at most supermarkets)
- Clear film (for the example I used a silicone non slip mat but you could use transparency paper or lunch wrap)
- Sharpies (black and coloured)
- Hot glue
- Scissors
- Wire (or string for hanging)

Instructions

Note: If you don't have a preserving jar screw band then you could use any other circular item, you could even cut out the middle of a paper plate to use as the frame.

- 1- Place your band onto your clear film and draw around the inside with a sharpie then cut it out. Check it fits nicely before starting to colour.
- 2- Using your coloured sharpies to draw/trace the design you want for the sun catcher.
- 3- Use a black sharpie to outline the pattern to help it stand out.

Jar Lid Sun Catchers cont.

4- Once coloured in, glue your coloured film to the inside of the jar lid using hot glue.

5- Use wire to wrap around the jar lid. Leave a bit at the end to allow for a 'hook' feature. Add this to string or hook on a window fitting.

These look amazing with the sun shining through them.
